

Bathing Regulations

1. General Rules:

- This set of rules ensures the safety, hygiene, and well-being of all guests.
- The instructions of the lifeguards must be strictly followed.
- Non-compliance with the bathing regulations or instructions may result in expulsion or subscription cancellation.
- The facility is largely monitored by video surveillance to ensure safety.

2. Luggage and Valuables:

- Strollers and sports equipment can be left in the entrance area.
- Valuables should not be brought into the bathing area. A security safe is available for rent (CHF 2).
- Always carry your locker wristband and safe key with you. Liability for theft is not assumed.

3. Hygiene Regulations:

- Showering before entering the pools is mandatory.
- Burkinis (swimsuits) are permitted but must be made of Lycra or Elastane.

4. Safety Guidelines:

- Enter and exit the pools only through the designated entry and exit points.
- Caution is required in indoor and outdoor areas due to the risk of slipping.
- No liability is assumed for accidents outside the designated access points.

5. Health Precautions:

- In case of emergency, press the "Bath Alarm" button only.
- Individuals with health concerns (e.g., heart problems, circulatory issues) should consult a doctor beforehand.

6. Thermal Baths:

- The maximum stay in thermal baths is limited to 20 minutes (10 minutes for children).
- Entry to the steam grotto is permitted from the age of 16, with a maximum duration of 3 x 2 minutes.

7. Children and Non-Swimmers:

- Toddlers must wear swim aids and aqua diapers under supervision.
- Non-swimmers should enter the thermal baths with caution.
- Non-swimmers are prohibited from entering the sports pool.

8. Sports and Play Areas:

- Jumping is only allowed from the designated starting blocks in the sports pool.
- The water slide may only be used when the green light is on and one person at a time.

9. Sauna and Steam Bath Area:

- Entry is allowed from the age of 16 and requires an additional fee.
- The sauna area is a clothing-free zone; wearing swimwear is not permitted.

10. Other Rules of Conduct:

- Sun loungers cannot be reserved; absolute silence is required in the relaxation rooms.
- Alcohol consumption must be kept to a reasonable level. Leukerbad Therme reserves the right to limit alcohol service and deny further consumption to intoxicated guests.
- Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is only allowed in designated outdoor areas.
- Filming and photography are not permitted in the bathing and sauna areas.
