Back in the day, the Romans were already aware of the healing properties of the hot springs in Leukerbad. The geothermal bathing resort is located in a well-protected area in a valley at the side of Valais, at the foot of the Gemmi Pass, and is now a travel destination for wellness and sports enthusiasts.

Together with the municipalities of Albinen, Inden and Varen, the spa village within the Pfyn-Finges Nature Park has joined together to form the destination Leukerbad.



Panorama Way Torrent



Skiing

Powdered slopes and an enchanting snow-covered mountain world: the two ski areas of Torrent and Snowpark Sportarena in Leukerbad are a fantastic surprise for snow sports fans of all ages. The children's ski area in the village is ideal for families.

Winter Hiking

Culture in Inden

The Valais village of Inden is located on the Dala-Raspille cultural trail, which leads from Leukerbad to the well-known wine villages of Varen and Salgesch. A beautiful playground, the late baroque church, the Antonius chapel dating back over 500 years and the 270° cinema invite you to visit.



Wine in Varen

Archaeological excavations show that settlements in Varen began as early as the Bronze Age. The area was first mentioned in 1241 in a sales deed for a vineyard. The centuries-old knowledge of wine-growing can be felt and experienced throughout the village. Enjoy the excellent Valais wines and specialties. Take a hike through the vineyards and visit the ten wineries that are run exclusively as family businesses.



Special Feature: Nature

The natural spectacle of the Gemmi

If you go to the Gemmi from Leukerbad, you enter another world that will enchant you with its spellbinding charm.

Once you have reached the top of the pass on foot or by gondola, your gaze inevitably reaches for the sky. With a bit of luck, you can spot golden eagles and bearded vultures here. There is also a lot to discover on the Lämmerenboden, to the east of the pass. Animals and plants – nature takes on many forms up here! Not forgetting the Wildstrubel glacier, even if you don't notice it at first glance. A glacier path leads from the Gemmi Pass to the Lämmerenhütte at its foot.

Was there a stream here before?

About 200 years ago, the end of the glacier tongue was where the glacier path began. Today it is about 2 kilometres further up the valley, but still provides a large part of the water that forms today's floodplain landscape. Sometimes you see it as a trickle, sometimes as a raging brook. If you stay a little longer up here, you can even watch the magic unfold over the course of the day and discover the strange shapes that the glacier has left behind over time. Also, the diverse plants that have settled in the barren and a constantly changing landscape.

Fur bearers and feathered giants

But the landscape may just have its show stolen by something or someone else! Maybe one of the marmots, a member of the ibex colony, or a mountain hare that travels up here with visibly thicker fur than its cousins in the lowlands. And if you look up into the sky, you might be lucky enough to spot one of the kings of the air next to the cheeky Alpine choughs. Both the majestic golden eagle and the giant bearded vulture are at home up here. If you then wish to discover fossils that the primordial sea left here millions of years ago, it is best to reserve more than just one day for the exploration tour in the glacier foreland.





Sustainability

As the most important tourism service provider and largest employer in the area, My Leukerbad AG is aware of its responsibility to use the various resources such as water, snow and energy in a sustainable and efficient manner. My Leukerbad AG has committed itself to improving the energy efficiency of its operations every year. To this end, the destination has joined various projects and promotes the sustainable use of resources in the region.

Sustainable geothermal water

3.9 million litres of geothermal water gush out of the mountain every day at up to 51° Celsius. Thanks to the natural occurrence of geothermal water, we can offer our guests an energy-efficient bathing experience. With us, the power consumption for the geothermal water is only 5–10% compared to a bath with heated tap water.

Climate-neutral ski passes & key cards

In the winter season, the ski passes for the Torrent cableways are climate-neutral. An extension to the summer season is being planned. By purchasing a subscription, guests support the myclimate "Cause We Care" fund with one franc. The amount will be doubled by My Leukerbad AG. By returning the key card at the end of their stay, guests donate a further five francs.

We are committed to achieving the energy efficiency and CO2 targets agreed with the Federal Office of Energy. By 2027, we will implement measures and projects to increase the energy efficiency of My Leukerbad AG every year. If the target is reached, the Federal Office of Energy reimburses the network surcharge and the funds released are then reinvested in further sustainability measures.

Switzerland Tourism's sustainability strategy Swisstainable promotes sustainable tourism through natural offers, promotion of local consumption and longer-term stays. Thanks to its diverse sustainability measures, My Leukerbad AG has already achieved level 2 "engaged" by Swisstainable. Our concrete measures are energetic renovations of technical installations and buildings, the promotion of natural offers such as wine and cheese from the region as well as numerous experiences in the Pfyn-Finges Nature Park.

Getting There

You can easily reach Leukerbad by train, bus, taxi or car. If you are arriving by car, there are numerous multi-storey car parks available on site. For those arriving via an airport, you can take the train and reach Leukerbad within 3.5 hours from Zurich Airport and within 3 hours from Geneva Airport.



By public transport
